# Exercise in the subject course – In & Out project

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## A. Give the place a name

### **B1** Description

This exercise can you do on every selected place that you work with, in order to get a relation to the place. Maybe you have been and worked on the place before and have learned a lot of the place's history or maybe it's the first time you are in that place. Pupils train a lot of cooperation and discussing in this exercise and there are also mathematic and biology involved in an interdisciplinary way. Physical activities are all the time involved when the pupils run and fetch things. They also learn how to spell names.
